Three-Time Olympian Helps Celebrate a Milestone Achievement

Recently, Brewer FCU was part of a celebration— a big one! At an event that featured three-time Olympian **Devon Harris**, one of the inspirations behind the blockbuster movie *Cool Runnings*, the official, record-breaking total for the 2017 Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger was announced: \$740,027.35, a new fundraising milestone.

Harris, who formed a foundation in 2006 which includes helping make sure children have enough to eat so they can do better in school, praised the credit union effort. "You are providing hope to kids I was once like. Empty cupboard, no food, been there done that. The help that the credit unions in Maine are giving to kids and adults, in general, through your Campaign is amazing. You have found a cause and you are making a difference in the lives of the people in your state. What I would say to you in closing, though, is don't stop now – the need remains and people need the hope that having enough to eat provides."

Since 1990, the Maine Credit Unions' Campaign for Ending Hunger has raised more than \$8 million to help end hunger in Maine. All contributions to the Campaign are tax-deductible.
