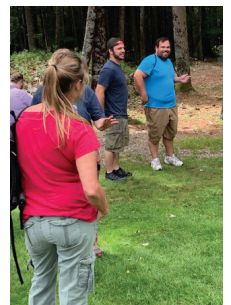
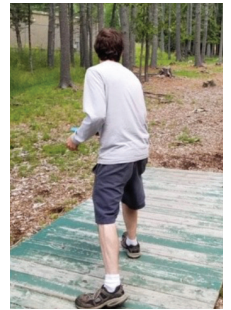

Five New England Fall Travel Ideas For 2019

Autumn is a beautiful time of year in New England. There's a crisp chill hanging in the air and the mornings are glazed in a gentle frost. The landscape is painted with brilliant reds and yellows, making for the perfect family photograph. Make the most of your fall season with these budget-minded travel ideas:

1. Great Maine Apple Day in Unity, ME, takes place on Sunday, October 14 at the Common Ground Education Center. There will be cider pressing, workshops, talks, apple art, and a walk through the Maine Heritage Orchard. Depending on your baking skills, you can enter a pie in the apple pie contest.
2. Take a train to the apple orchards of Belkin Family Lookout Farm in Natick, MA. This farm is one of the oldest in the country, and features live entertainment, face painting, farm animals, and for the adults, the Lookout Taproom with its very own craft ciders.

3. Visit Acadia National Park. Though lovely in the summer, some prefer to go in the fall. There is an expanse of scenic, rocky coast to be explored along with valleys, lakes, and mountains. You may even spot a moose or two!

4. Plan and embark on a scenic road trip up and down the coast of New England. Some travel from Portland, ME to Boston, MA to Newport, RI. There are plenty of worthy stops along the way and a road trip can be a great way to bond with family and friends.

5. For those who appreciate organic and low-spray apple orchards, there are a number of options in the state of Maine, including Apple Acres Farm in Hiram and Ricker Hill Orchards in Turner. Take the kids and make some memories!
